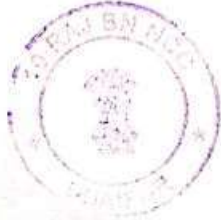

These achievements reflect the dedication, hard work, and talent of the cadets from Techno India NJR.







##### **1. Run for Maj Mustafa:**


