Plan and PVR NEST have collaborated with Centre for Youth (hereinafter referred to as C4Y), a not for profit society duly registered society under the provision of the Society Registration Act, 1860 vide registration number S/1760 registered at New Delhi on 4th December 2014 having office at 81B, IInd Floor, DDA Flats, ShahpurJat, New Delhi 110049 as a technical partner to provide technical inputs for successful implementation of the collaboration between Plan India and PVR NEST.
- C. Plan India, PVR NEST and C4Y have formulated a detailed Implementation Plan for execution of the collaboration/MOU.
- D. C4Y has invited innovative proposals from the interested youth through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process which included an advertisement to public at large through websites by holding awareness workshops at various academic institutions in the cities of Delhi, Lucknow, Dehradun, Jaipur and Udaipur during August 2018. In response to this Call for Proposal, a total of about 200 proposals were received by C4Y from the youth of these five cities, and 30 were shortlisted for second round and for mentoring support.
- E. The 2nd party hereto was one of applicants as it has submitted a proposal titled "Wricks: low cost and environment friendly bricks and related products using waste materials." (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), which is annexed to this agreement as Annexure-II, and
- F. C4Y has constituted a Jury consisting of Sectoral Experts Committee (Jury) to scrutinize and shortlist the top 10 to 12 proposals based on a pre-defined criteria. The Sectoral Expert Committee members met on November 05, 2018 at New Delhi and selected final innovative 10 proposals for Eco Grants. One partners choice proposal was also selected mutually by all the partners. Further, Plan India engaged Ms. Grant Thornton LLP to undertake a process audit of the overall selection process. The proposal submitted by the 2nd party was one of the successful proposals approved by the Jury for financial support in the form of grant.
- G. Plan India and ALAMB have entered into a grant agreement on 15th March 2019 whereby ALAMB has been entrusted with the responsibility to administer the smooth and efficient implementation of the successful proposals by releasing the grant to each selected grantee and to report on the same to Plan India from time to time

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set out in this Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

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1. Definitions

In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

- a. "Project" means as described in Recital 'c' above, a copy of which is annexed herewith at Annexure-II;
- b. "Project Implementation Process and Protocol" is a comprehensive guideline to be complied by 2nd party during Project implementation. This document is attached hereto as Annexure-III;
- c. "Grant" shall mean a sum of Rs.450000/- (Indian Rupees Four Lakh Fifty Thousand only) to be paid by ALAMB to 2nd Party for the implementation of the Project as aforesaid;
- d. "Confidential Information" has the meaning assigned to it in Clause 6 hereof;
- e. "Project Duration" shall mean the period from 15th April 2019 to 15th October, 2019

2. Project Implementation Grant Disbursement & its Utilisation

- a. ALAMB shall provide the Grant to the 2nd Party for the Project activity as per Annexure-I during the tenure of the project.
- b. 2nd Party undertakes to use the grant amount only for implementing the Project during the period from 15th April 2019 to 15th October, 2019;
- c. The grant amount shall be disbursed by ALAMB to the 2nd Party as per following schedule:
 - i) 1st Installment: 40% of the Grant to be released immediately on signing of this agreement;
 - ii) 2nd Installment: 2nd tranche of 40% to be released on receipt of mid-term report at the end of 3rd month of the project and its recommendation from C4Y.
 - iii) 3rd & Final Installment: Final 20% of the grant will be disbursed to the 2nd Party after receipt of Final report on completion of the Project and its recommendation from C4Y.
 - iv) Payment will be made directly into the bank account of 2nd Party as per details below through online bank transfer:

- d. 2nd Party shall utilize the funds for the project implementation, keep records of the utilisation and submit required reports to ALAMB on a periodic basis as outlined in this agreement.
- e. Any funds that are not spent at the end of the date specified above (the "Grant Period") must be promptly returned or refunded to ALAMB, unless ALAMB gives prior written approval to a written request proposing how unspent funds will be used, or to a written request for an extension of the Grant Period. Proposals for the use of unspent funds must be for work that is consistent with the overall aims of the Grant. 2nd Party is not allowed to use the unspent funds without the prior written approval of ALAMB.
- f. Requests for further funding must be the subject of a new application.

3. Accounts, Records and Audit

- 3.1. 2nd Party will be responsible for utilisation of the grant and to account for the same by maintaining required accounting records and vouchers.

3.2 All expenses related to the Project are to be made on the basis of original bills / invoices from vendors, duly reviewed and approved by staff of 2nd Party and accounted on a regular basis. ALAMB will provide the instructions and guidelines to the 2nd party for this purpose.

3.3 2nd Party shall submit an Utilisation Certificate to ALAMB along with the program reports (mid-term and final). ALAMB/C4Y will guide and instruct 2nd Party about the format and process for submitting the Utilisation Certificate and related documents.

3.4 ALAMB/C4Y or its representatives / auditors, on giving reasonable notice in writing to 2nd party, may visit the offices of 2nd party to review and audit the accounts and records and 2nd Party shall cooperate with such teams during the review and provide access to accounts and records pertaining to the utilization of the funds.

3.5 2nd Party undertakes to handover all original vouchers and supporting documents/records to ALAMB at the time of submission of UC for safe keeping and any future reference purpose. ALAMB will issue an acknowledgement in favour of 2nd Party on receipt of the original vouchers.

4. Monitoring and Reporting

4.1 C4Y is responsible for all project monitoring work and to give suitable technical support to the 2nd Party from time to time for successful completion of the Project.

4.2 2nd Party shall submit periodic reports to C4Y on a timely basis and C4Y will submit to ALAMB. Apart from routine reports, a mid-term project report and a project completion report are required as per the Proforma to be provided by C4Y.

4.3 Reporting timelines and requirements are detailed in Annexure-III to this agreement.

4.4 C4Y will make periodic field visits for on the spot review of the project and to provide technical support to the 2nd Party.

5. Term and Termination

5.1 This AGREEMENT shall remain in force from the date of execution of this AGREEMENT unless terminated in accordance with the provisions hereof.

5.2 2nd Party must inform ALAMB/C4Y without delay of any change to its legal status which might affect its ability to comply with these terms and conditions and any changes in its management.

5.3 2nd Party must inform ALAMB/C4Y as soon as practicable of any material divergence from the original aims and direction of the Grant.

5.4 This AGREEMENT may be terminated by ALAMB or 2nd Party after giving prior written notice of thirty (30) days to each other.

5.5 In the event of: (i) fraud; (ii) misappropriation of funds; or (iii) non-compliance of the terms and condition herein by 2nd Party or where 2nd Party is found involved in any manner or form in corrupt practices or misappropriating the funds/assets, which belongs to ALAMB. ALAMB may, at its sole discretion and at any time, terminate the AGREEMENT and inform 2nd Party of its decision in writing which shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The AGREEMENT shall stand terminated on the date as mentioned in the written communication by ALAMB.

6. Confidentiality

6.1 Each Party shall keep the contents of this AGREEMENT, and any other information shared/ disclosed by them with/ to each other in relation thereto, including information shared/ disclosed prior to the date of this AGREEMENT, (collectively, the "Confidential Information") confidential and shall not without the prior written consent of the other Party, disclose or divulge the Confidential Information to any third party or to any other Person (other than on a need to know basis to the Receiving Party's

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directors, officers, employees and advisors who are involved in the transaction and are subject to an equivalent obligation of confidentiality or to the extent required by any Applicable Law).

6.2 Both the Parties need to seek requisite permission/approvals for using any logo and/ or name of ALAMB/C4Y or Plan India or PVR Nest in any of the promotional material prior its usage.

6.3 The provisions of this clause shall survive the expiry or termination of this Agreement.

7. Publicity, Communication

7.1 During this agreement period, without prior written approval from ALAMB/C4Y, 2nd Party will not make any publication or statement or communication on any public platform, social media forums or press, electronic or print media about the following:

- Grant/Project and association of 2nd Party with ALAMB/C4Y, Plan India and PVR Nest; and
- As and when any significant event relating to the Project takes place.

7.2 Acknowledgement – An acknowledgement of the source of the Grant must appear in 2nd Party's annual audited accounts if any and its annual report and, where appropriate, in its brochure or information booklet.

7.3 2nd Party may seek approval in writing to use ALAMB/C4Y, Plan India or PVR NEST logo in any publicity relating to the Grant and the same will be subject to logo guidelines and written approval of ALAMB/C4Y, Plan India and PVR Nest.

8. Intellectual Property

8.1 With respect to the Project proposal and its concept and process, Plan India, PVR NEST and C4Y shall have a non-exclusive, and irrevocable right to apply or use the same or reproduce, publish, or otherwise use it for their organizational interests and they will not have any financial liability or costs for such action.

9. Representations and warranties

2nd Party represents warrants and confirms to ALAMB that as of the date hereof and the dates of the written requests for payment:

- It has the right, power and authority and has taken all actions necessary to execute and deliver this Agreement, and to exercise its rights and perform its obligations as set out in this Agreement;
- This Agreement constitutes legal, valid and binding obligations of 2nd Party enforceable in accordance with its terms;
- The execution and delivery of, and the performance of obligations under and compliance with the provisions of, this Agreement by 2nd Party will not result in:
 - any breach of, conflict with, result in the acceleration of, create in any third party the right to accelerate, terminate, modify or cancel, require any notice, or constitute a default under, any, agreement or instrument to which 2nd Party is a party or by which it is bound; or
 - any violation of any applicable laws or regulations or of any order, judgment or decree of any court or governmental agency by which 2nd Party is bound;
- No consent, authorization, license or approval or notice to any third party or any governmental authority that has not been made or obtained is required to authorize the execution, delivery, validity or enforceability of this Agreement, the consummation of the actions and transactions contemplated under this agreement, or for the performance by 2nd Party of any of its obligations hereunder; and
- No suit, action, investigation, inquiry or other proceeding by any authority or legal or administrative proceeding is pending or has been threatened against 2nd Party, which may affect the validity or enforceability of this Agreement or the actions and transactions contemplated hereby or the 2nd

Party's ability to consummate the actions and transactions contemplated hereby.

9. Force Majeure

a. If the performance of the agreement by either Party is delayed, hindered or prevented or is otherwise frustrated by reason of force majeure, which shall mean war, hostilities, riot or civil commotion, fire, flood or earthquake, tempest, lightning or other natural physical disaster, restrictions imposed by the government or any government authority which prevents or delays the performance of obligations of any Party hereunder which is beyond the control of the Parties, then the Party so affected shall promptly notify the other Party in writing specifying the nature of the force majeure and of the anticipated delay in the performance of the MOU. From the date of such notification by 2nd Party, ALAMB shall at its sole discretion, either terminate the Agreement forthwith or suspend the performance of the Agreement for a period not exceeding six (6) months. If at the expiry of the period of suspension upto a maximum of six months, the reasons for the suspension still remain, ALAMB and 2nd Party shall treat the Agreement as terminated.

10. Governing law and jurisdiction

a. All aspects of the relationship created by this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. In case of any dispute or difference arising out of this Agreement, without it constituting any precondition to initiation of any legal action or proceedings, the parties will first attempt resolution of such dispute or difference through good faith discussions.

b. Any action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be brought and maintained exclusively in the courts at New Delhi which courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction in relation to such action or proceedings.

11. Anti-corruption and Sanctions

a. 2nd Party covenants that it will not, and nor will any of the officers, employees, associates, partners, members or shareholders, representatives or agents ("associated parties") of 2nd Party, directly or indirectly, make or offer any payment, gift or other advantage with respect to any matters which are the subject of this Agreement which: (i) would violate any anti-corruption laws or regulations applicable to 2nd Party or ALAMB, (ii) is intended to, or does, influence or reward any person for acting in breach of an expectation of good faith, impartiality or trust, or which it would otherwise be improper for the recipient to accept, (iii) is made to or for a public official with the intention of influencing them and obtaining or retaining an advantage in the conduct of business, (iv) is made to a public official for the purpose of expending or securing the performance of a routine governmental action by the public official. For the avoidance of doubt, "public official" means an officer or employee of a government (including its agencies and departments), a government-owned or government-controlled entity, a regulatory entity, a public international organization, or a political party, or any person acting in an official capacity of the same. 2nd Party represents that it is not a government entity or instrumentality nor is acting on behalf of any government entity or instrumentality. 2nd Party covenants that should it know or have reason to know of a potential breach of any of the foregoing it will promptly notify ALAMB. Breach of any of the foregoing covenants and representations shall be grounds for termination of this Agreement by ALAMB at its sole discretion.

b. 2nd Party undertakes not to use the Grant under this Agreement directly or indirectly for any illegal and unlawful activities as defined by the Govt. or by any prevailing laws of India.

12. Child protection policy:

2nd Party undertakes that it is committed to the actualizing of child rights and is obligated to provide children with whom it works a safe and conducive environment. ALAMB is bound to fully adhere to Plan India's Child Protection Policy named "Policy for Safeguarding Children and Young People" (attached herewith as **Annexure-IV**) and accordingly, the policy also applies to the 2nd Party which undertakes to comply with the same. Any violation of the code of conduct as described in the policy is

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considered by ALAMB and Plan India a serious contempt to children and ALAMB reserves its right to intervene in such circumstances.

9. Miscellaneous

a) **No Agency:** Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed or have effect as constituting a relationship of employer and employee or principal and agent between ALAMB and 2nd Party. 2nd Party shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of its staff and any persons, partners, associations, institutions engaged by 2nd Party and for the health, safety and security of such persons or entities and their property and for compliance with applicable labor laws.

b) **Indemnity:** 2nd Party hereby agrees to indemnify and hold ALAMB harmless against any/all losses, claims, damages, costs and expenses that ALAMB may suffer either on account of any act or omission of 2nd Party or any third person claiming through or on breach of any representation, warranty and covenant made under this Agreement by 2nd Party.

c) **Assignment:** 2nd Party shall not assign, transfer, novate or sub-contract any of its rights and obligations under this Agreement without ALAMB prior written consent.

d) **Severability:** If any provision of this Agreement is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable for whatever reason, such provision shall be severed from this Agreement without affecting the legality, validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions. The affected provision(s) shall be replaced with a lawful, valid and enforcement provision(s) that is as close as possible to the original purpose intended by the Parties.

e) **Waiver:** The failure of either party to enforce at any time the provisions of this Agreement shall in no way be constituted to be a present or future waiver of such provisions, and shall not in any way affect the right of either party to enforce each and every such provision thereafter.

f) **Entire Agreement:** This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the Parties hereto with respect to the transactions envisaged in this Agreement, cancelling or superseding all other proposals, negotiations, prior discussions, understandings, arrangements, preliminary agreements, memoranda etc. made prior to the date hereof whether oral or written, with respect to the transactions envisaged hereunder.

g) **Amendment:** This Agreement shall not be amended or modified except by an instrument in writing signed by or on behalf of all the Parties.

h) **Notice:** Any notice or other communication by any Party hereto to the other pursuant to or in connection with this Agreement shall be given in writing and may be sent by post, email or by hand delivery or courier to the addresses indicated herein above and to the attention of the person mentioned below and shall be deemed to be received on the date of delivery thereof.
