

पिछले माह उदयपुर में हुए डीजी फेस्ट में हैकार्यान-2017 में दूसरे स्थान पर आने वाले टेक्नो इंडिया एनजेआर इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ टेक्नोलॉजी के छात्रों को सरकार ने वक ऑडर जारी कर दिया है। हैकाथॉन में किसानों के लिए बनाए गए इनके प्रोजेक्ट को 1800 छात्रों के बीच दूसरा स्थान मिला था। एप में फसलों को लगने वाली बीमारी का पता करने के लिए विशेष तकनीक इस्तेमाल की है। किसान अपनी फसल के सामने जाकर इस एप को शुरू करेगा तो इसमें लगे कैम्रे फसल की फोटो लेकर उसमें क्या बीमारी है, बता देगा। इसके साथ इस बीमारी का समाधान कैसे हो सकता है इसकी भी जानकारी देगा। नजदीकी केंद्र के नंबर भी देगा। इसके अतिरिक्त फसल की बुवाई से लेकर कटाई तक की जानकारी भी एप में मिलेगी। फसलों के समर्थन मूल्य से लेकर बाजार में क्या कीमत चल रही है इसकी जानकारी भी प्राप्त कर सकते हैं।

एप प्लान बनाने वाले छात्रों को १० लाख रुपए की प्राइज मनी मिलेगी और सरकार के साथ इन्हें काम 2017 में टेक्नो इंजीनियरिंग कॉलेज के रित्वक जोशी, यश कोठारी, भव्य दवे, विवेक छांची और वंश सोनी की टीम वॉटलैंब्स ने किसानों के लिए 'फार्मर फ्रेंड'' नाम से एप तैयार किया था। यह एप सरकार को पंसद आया और प्रवेश सरकार ने वर्कऑर्डर छात्रों को दे दिया है। इसके तहत सूचना एवं प्रौद्योगिकी विभाग के संयुक्त निवेशक रमेश चंद्र शर्मा को छात्रों का ऑफिसर इंचार्ज कम मेंटर बनाया गया है। हैकॉधान में चयनित किए गए टॉप-3 टीमों में से राजस्थान से यह एकमात्र टीम वी।





Plan and PVR NEST have collaborated with Centre for Youth (hereinafter referred to as C4Y), a not for profit society duly registered society under the provision of the Society Registration Act, 1860 vide registration number 31/760 registered at New Delhi on 4th Desember 2014 having office at 81B, Ilind Ploor, DDA Flats, Shahpunda, New Delhi 170498as a technical partner to provide technical inputs for successful implementation of the collaboration between Plan India and PVR NEST.
- C. Plan India, PVR NEST and C4Y have formulated a detailed Implementation Plan for execution of the collaboration/MOU
- D. C4Y has invited innovative proposals from the interested youth through aRequest for Proposal (RFP)processwhich included an advertisement to public at large through websites by holding awareness workshops at various academic institutions in the cities of Dehh, Lucknow, Dehradun, Jaipur and Udaipur during August 2018. In response to this Call for Proposal, a total of about 200 proposals were received by C4Y from the youth of these five cities, and 30 were shortlisted for second round and for mentoring support.
- E. The 2nd party hereto was one of applicants as it has submitted a proposal titled "Wricks: Low cost and environment friendly bricks and related products using waste materials", (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), which is ameased to this agreement as <u>Annexure-1</u>, and
- F. C4Y has constituted a Jury consisting of Sectoral Experts Committee (jury)to scrutinize and shortlist the top 10 to 12 proposels based on a pre-defined criteria. The Sectoral Expert Committee members met on November 05, 2018 at New Delhi and selected final innovative 10 proposals for Eco Grants. One partners choice proposal was also selected mutually by all the partners Further. Plan India engaged Mix Grant Thronton LLP to undertake a process audit of the overallelection process. The proposal submitted by the 2" party was one of the successful proposals approved by the Jury for financial support in the form of grant.
- G. Plan India and ALAMB have entered into a grant agreement on 15th March 2019 whereby ALAMB has been entrusted with the responsibility to administer the smooth and efficient implementation of the successful proposals by releasing the grant to each selected grantee and to report on the same to Plan India from time to time

Definitions
 In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

Any funds that are not spent at the end of the date specified above (the "Grant Period") must be promptly returned or refunded to ALAMB, unless ALAMB gives prior written approval to a written request proposing how unspent funds will be used, or to a written request for a extension of the Grant Period. 


